



Above photo of the cross was carved by a farmer who, at great personal risk, saved the remains and personal affects of pilot Capt. F.D.Pemberton RFC. when he was shot down over France and mortally wounded on 21st August 1917. At the end of the War the farmer contacted the family, the cross was recovered from the french field and was placed in Christ Church Cathedral, Victoria, where it now hangs.
